Any person who submits a frivolous complaint shall be liable for actual and compensatory damages to the alleged violator for holding the alleged violator before the public in a false light. A finding by the Commission that a complaint is frivolous or without probable cause shall be a public record.

PLEASE STATE THE FACTS BELOW:

On or about February 23, 2016, Michael E. Carter ("Carter") filed to be a Republican Candidate for State Senator in District 23. A State Senator candidate must form a committee and file a Statement of Committee Organization if the total contributions received or if the total expenditures made on behalf of the candidate exceed \$500.00 or if a single contributor other than the candidate contributes more than \$325.00. R.S.Mo. § 130.016. The Statement of Committee Organization must be filed within twenty days of the committee's formation. R.S.Mo. § 130.021.5.

On February 23, 2016, an electronic mailer announcing that Carter had filed to be a candidate in the election was released. Beginning in March of 2016, robocalls began being made by or on behalf of Carter's Senate campaign, and upon information and belief they continue to be made. Additionally, sponsored ads in support of Carter's Senate campaign appeared on Facebook prior to June 10, 2016.

According to the Missouri Ethics Commission's (MEC) website, a Candidate Committee named "Michael E. Carter", MEC ID C161282, was established no sooner (and perhaps later) than June 30, 2016 in association with Carter's campaign for State Senator in District 23. A search of the MEC's website reveals that the only other active committee associated with Carter is a Candidate Committee named "Vote4carter.com", MEC ID A151075, which was established in association with Carter's 2015 campaign for municipal Judge of the City of Wentzville. It should be noted that the February 23, 2016 electronic mailer discussed in the preceding paragraph reflected that it was "Paid for by Vote4Carter.com Committee, Janet Kontz Treasurer". However, Vote4Carter.com Committee's Disclosure Report for the period of January 1, 2016 to March 31, 2016 reflects that the Committee made no expenditures, (Please see attached addendum for continuation of statement facts).

contributions, or disbursements during that time period, except for the payment of bank fees. Additionally, it is unclear if that Committee was properly formed and existing at the time it made its contribution to Carter's Senate race.

I have a good faith basis to believe that the cost of the robocalls and sponsored Facebook ads, along with other expenditures made on behalf of Carter's campaign for State Senator in District 23, exceeded \$500.00 prior to June 10, 2016. Thus, Carter had an obligation to form a committee prior to June 10, 2016 and to submit a Statement of Committee Organization prior to June 30, 2016. (Indeed, the only report actually available for the Committee shows that it was not received until July 11, 2016.) As the Michael E. Carter Committee was established with the MEC no sooner than June 30, 2016, I have a good faith basis to believe that Carter failed to comply with campaign finance disclosure requirements under R.S.Mo. Chapter 130 by failing to timely form a committee and/or by failing to register a committee within 20 days of its formation. In addition to the materials I enclose with this complaint, I also have recordings of robocalls and will make those available upon this Commission's request.

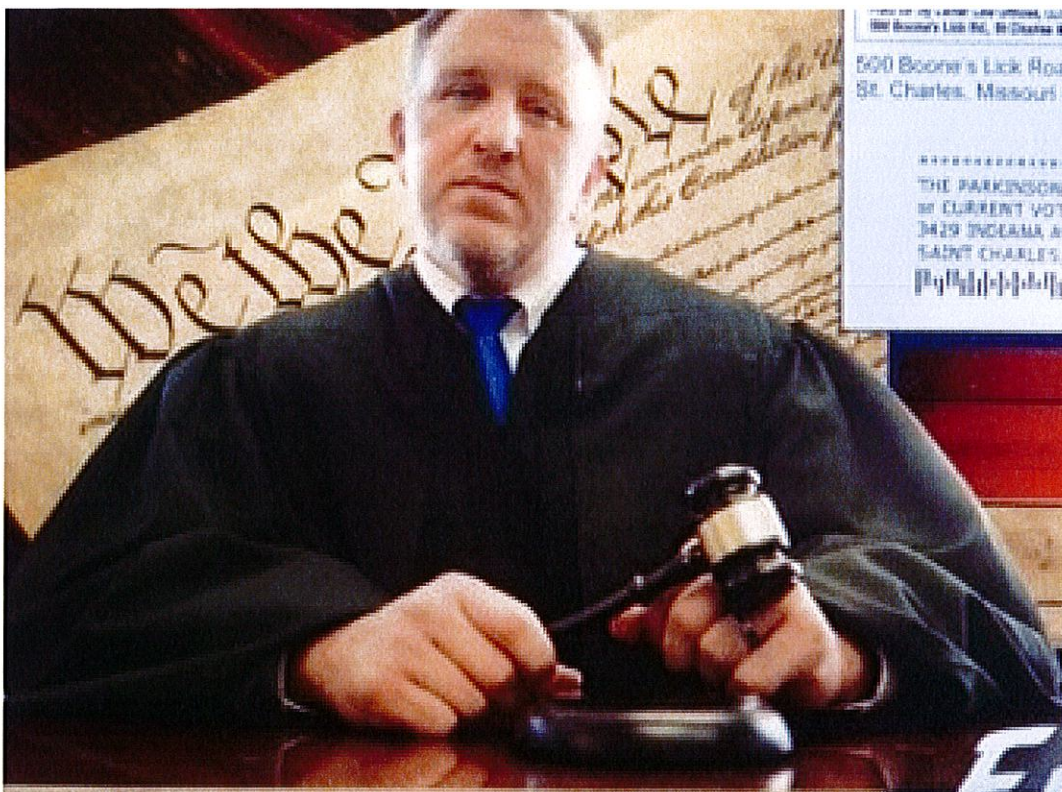

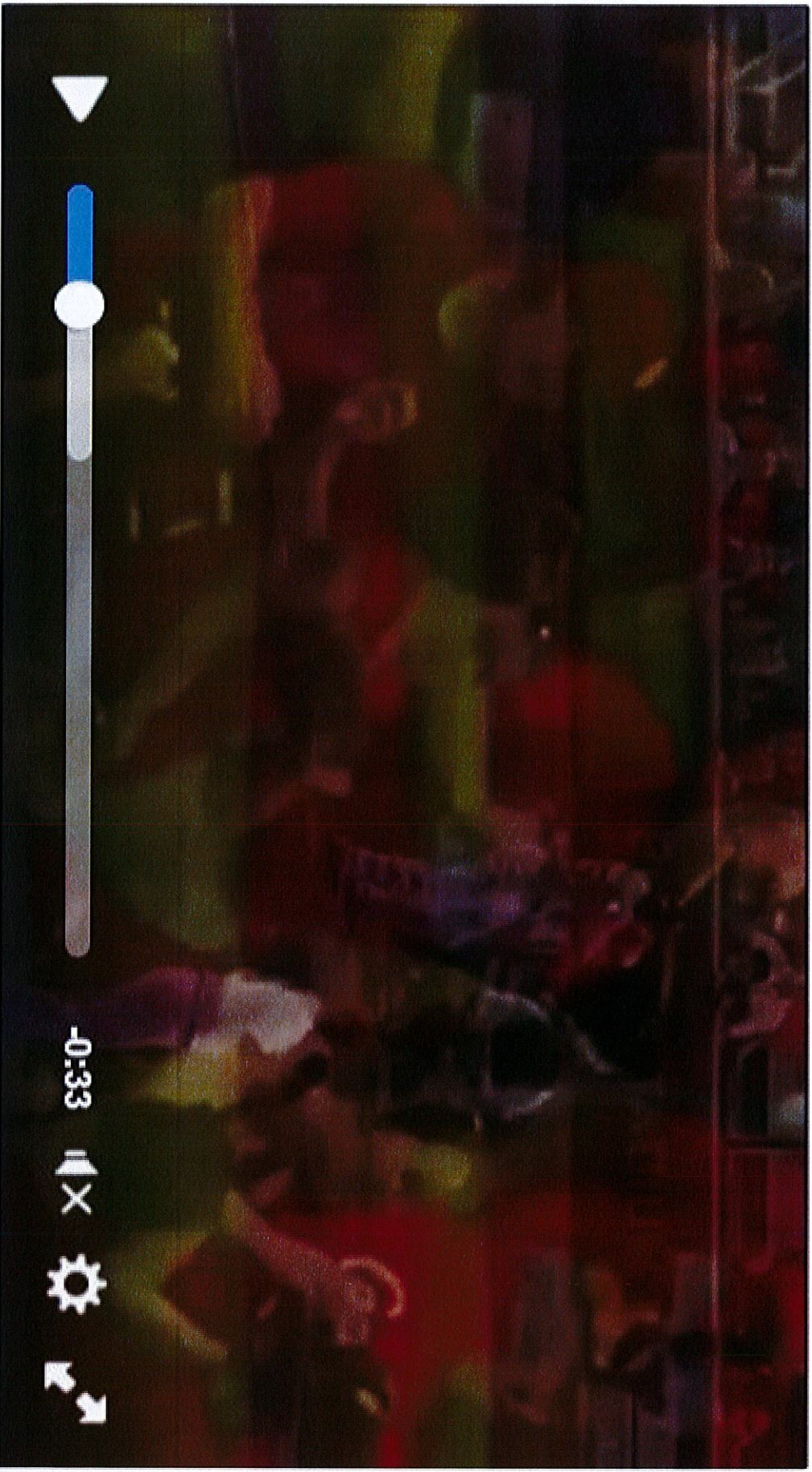

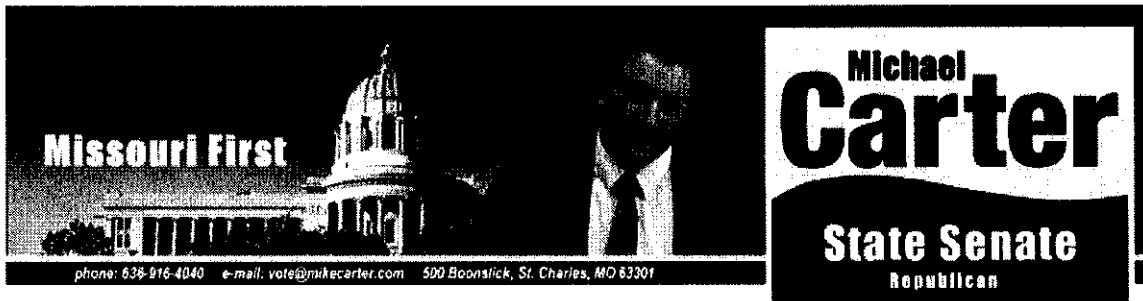

St. Charles Missouri, February 23, 2016

St. Charles attorney and Judge Michael Carter filed today in the Republican Primary for the 23rd District State Senate seat. The seat is currently vacant following the departure of former State Senator Tom Dempsey. "When you look at what is going on nationally, people are sick of politics as usual. They are fed up with hand-picked successors, political dynasties, and special interest politicians. I love going to Jefferson City, as unbelievable as that sounds I really do; but, in more ways than not it is just as broken as Washington. The will of the people is often ignored and it can feel that no one cares about those people who should be our first priority -- the good people that work hard, pay the bills, follow the rules, and don't have time to get to the state capitol to speak for themselves," declared Carter.

"My roots, my family, and my business are in this community. I didn't move into the district to run for office. People know that I will stand up and fight for their interests. **They know I worked to ban the profiteering red light cameras in Wentzville which led the way for passage of a countywide ban.** Ask anyone who knows anything about red-light traffic cameras in the St. Louis and St. Charles county areas and they know the name Mike Carter. I started the 'ban the cam' movement for all the right reasons and I will now finish it with a statewide ban,

I'm successful enough that I can't be bought and strong enough that I can't be bullied. The big money out-state foreigners and unions have begun funding their chosen candidates," says Carter.

Judge Carter said his major goals would be to:

- Pass A Statewide Ban On Red-Light, Speed, and Traffic Citation Cameras Generally.
- End The Bureaucratic Stranglehold On State and Local Government Programs - Make Bureaucrats Re-apply for Their Jobs Every Five Years Just Like the Elected Officials They Serve.
- Ensure that real-world application and common sense are considered in light of Municipal Court Reform Senate Bills 5 (2015) & 572 (2106). Though Reform Was Needed and Somewhat Welcomed Statewide, Municipal Courts Are Meant to Be Localized Centers of Behavior Modification in Their Respective Communities. Stripping Courts of The Means to Exact Appropriate Impartial and Measured Justice is Not the Answer.
- Pass Meaningful Ethics Reform and Put an End to The Frat House Atmosphere in Jefferson City.
- Make It Easier For Businesses To Flourish and Insert Business Efficiencies in Government Offices.
- Make It Easier To Challenge Property Tax Assessments and Other Seemingly Unilateral Governmental Rulings - Level The Playing Field In Administrative Hearings. (Carter is a 27 year REALTOR and Knows First Hand How Real Property Assessments Should Be Handled)
- Frequently Interact With Missouri Voters Through Direct Automated Telephonic Contact Wherein Voters Can Quickly and Easily Reveal Their Desires and Opinions About Crucial State Issues.

Carter says he is also running to see if real independent ideas and speaking candidly with voters can overcome money, big name endorsements and politics as usual; culminating in an elected Senator who is beholden to no one. This very same approach put Carter on the bench in Wentzville Missouri.

Michael Carter has an undergraduate degree from UMSL and both a Masters of Journalism and Juris Doctorate from Mizzou. Judge Mike Carter Congratulates Opponent Bill Eigel on His One-Year Anniversary in the District



ST. CHARLES, MO, June 17, 2016 --

Having lived in Missouri Senate District 23 for twenty-two years, Mike Carter is well aware of all the great things SD23 has to offer. "It's an amazing place to live and a great place to raise kids.
