MUNICIPAL DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY ELECTION

2017

Survey conducted January 24 through January 25, 2017. 917 likely St. Louis Municipal Democratic Primary voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2017 Municipal Democratic Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-3.16% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of The Missouri Times. Previous week survey results in parentheses.



Q: The candidates in the Municipal Primary Election for Mayor of Saint Louis are Antonio French, Lewis Reed, Jeffrey Boyd, Tishaura Jones, Lyda Krewson, Bill Haas and Jimmie Matthews. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Antonio French: 13% (13%)
Lewis Reed: 18% (18%)
Jeffrey Boyd: 5% (4%)
Tishaura Jones: 8% (9%)
Lyda Krewson: 29% (27%)
Bill Haas: 2% (2%)
Jimmie Matthews: 2% (1%)
Undecided: 24% (26%)
