Executive Summary

Gravis Marketing, a nonpartisan research firm, conducted a random survey of 115 registered Republican voters across Missouri's 18^{th} State Senate District. The poll was conducted on July 26^{th} and has a margin of error of $\pm 9.1\%$. The totals may not round to 100% because of rounding. The survey was conducted using interactive voice responses. The results are weighted by voting demographics. The poll was paid for by the Missouri Times.






1) Do you plan to vote in the upcoming Republican Primary election in Missouri?
