Statement of facts:

Roe is the owner of Axiom Strategies, a consultant company that has subsidiaries that buy media, produce mailers, obtain polling and perform other campaign related services. One of those companies is called 'Ax Media'. Another is 'Remington Research Group'.

Roe's companies worked for several different committees, putting Roe in a position to coordinate their spending and actions. Here is a partial list of committee reports listing expenditures for Axiom Strategies and/or Ax Media and/or Remington Research Group:

1. SCF: 7/30/18 report
2. Chester Victory Committee: 7/30/18 report
3. MSCF: 8/1/30 report
4. Luetkemeyer for Senate: 7/30/18 report.
5. Liberty Alliance: 10/12/17 report

Roe is reported as having contributed \$25,000 to SCF on 7/25/18, and I contend that there is sufficient evidence of coordination that the \$25,000 contribution should have been subject to contribution limits and exceeded them. The MEC reports filed by SCF list only one contribution, that being by Roe for \$25,000. SCF reports also show only expenditures in one race, that for the District 9 Missouri House seat. Roe's companies also worked for Chester Victory Committee. Further, SCF reports show that all the expenditures except one were made to Roe's companies. The other expenditure was made to the Law Offices of James C. Thomas III, who is the treasurer of SCF. Roe was the only contributor and only outside recipient of expenditures by the committee. Therefore it is likely that Thomas coordinated with Roe and earmarked the contribution by Roe to be spent for Mik Chester and against Sheila Solon. Roe could have made his contribution directly to Chester Victory Committee, but he didn't, as it would have been in excess of the limit on contributions. It is evident that SCF was created with the sole intent of circumventing the contribution limits law.

There is also evidence of coordination between MSCF and Luetkemeyer. Roe's companies provided services for both. The Luetkemeyer for Senate reports indicate no funding for mailers on the reports of April 2018, July 2018 or 8 day before Primary report. Nor were there any late expenditure reports as having been spent for mailers. However, there are many entries on the Luetkemeyer for Senate reports for expenditures to Roe's companies for 'media placements' and 'robocalls'. The reports filed by MSCF include many reported expenditures to Roe's companies for mailers as well as other services.

My understanding is that prices for TV ad time are much lower for candidate committees than for other types of committees. See the following quotation from <http://www.mediaaudit.com/media-watchdog/political-advertising-rules-in-local-tv-buying-6-common-misconceptions/>: “Federal candidates are entitled to the lowest rates in the ‘class’ of time they purchase. When stations choose to accept advertising from local and statewide candidates, they tend to also apply the same consideration.”

At my home, my family received the mailers that I have included with this complaint. We received none from the Luetkemeyer for Senate committee and many from MSCF. Roe’s company Axiom Strategies is reported by Luetkemeyer’s candidate committee as having provided general consulting for him. I contend that unless there was coordination, it would be very unlikely that Roe or his consulting company would have recommended that Luetkemeyer NOT send out ANY mailers whatsoever in the six months prior to his election. Coordination is evident from the fact that Roe’s company sent out several mailers (I have included 10) for MSCF.

I have also included a photocopy of part of the July 22 St. Joseph News-Press article in which Luetkemeyer is quoted as saying “My opponent voted to raise taxes by nearly \$14 million, increased the size of county government and gave taxpayer-funded raises to politicians like himself.” Compare Luetkemeyer’s words to the mailer sent out by MSCF, which contains these words: “Harry Roberts raised government spending by \$4 million and increased local taxes by 13.8 million.” And “Harry Roberts gave taxpayer funded pay raises to politicians like himself...” Given the words used in common, it is unlikely that Luetkemeyer chose his words without coordination with MSCF. It is evident that his messaging was coordinated, through his general consultant Roe and Axiom Strategies, with the messaging used by MSCF.

I contend that coordination occurred between Luetkemeyer and his committee and MSCF. It allowed them to benefit from the lower TV advertising costs for candidate committees by allocating the TV purchase expenses to the candidate committee and mailer costs to MSCF. Coordination is also confirmed by the quotes by Luetkemeyer. I contend that the evidence of coordination is sufficient to require that expenditures by MSCF be reported as contributions to Luetkemeyer and be subject to campaign contribution limits.

On 8/10/18, another \$45,000 contribution from Roe to MSCF was reported by MSCF. It appears that they are preparing to repeat in the general election the same coordination used in the primary.

There is also evidence that USTL earmarked contributions to MSCF for Luetkemeyer. USTL contributed \$450,000 to MSCF prior to the primary election. USTL is a 501(c)(4) organization that promotes term limits and

supports those candidates who sign their pledge to support term limits. Both Harry Roberts and Luetkemeyer signed their pledge. It is very unlikely that USTL would normally have spent \$450,000 in a Missouri Senate race in which both candidates signed their pledge. USTL contributed the \$450,000 knowing that it would be spent in support of Tony Luetkemeyer and against Harry Roberts. I know this because Carl Bearden, a political operative, wrote the following on my Facebook page when only \$200,000 had been contributed by USTL to MSCF:

“I personally talked to and chastised USTL for the donation in question because I believe Harry is the right candidate for the 34th. They were led to believe, incorrectly I might add, that Harry was against term limits. Their SOLE purpose was to emphasize they would support term limit supporters and therefore oppose non-supporters. They did not receive money to spend specifically against Harry. They have done similar campaigns in other states.”

As can be seen from the quotation above, USTL acknowledged to Carl Bearden that they knew their contributions would be used to support Luetkemeyer. The fact that USTL went on to contribute another \$250,000 after Roberts had signed their pledge indicates that they had a different purpose for making those contributions than the sole purpose they claimed to Bearden. It is much more likely that their purpose in making those contributions was to satisfy a wealthy contributor who asked USTL to forward a large amount of money directly to MSCF. Under this scenario, USTL could have been given a significant financial incentive to comply with the request. In fact, Thomas, treasurer for MSCF, has been fined by the Federal Election Commission for just this sort of thing: <https://www.news-leader.com/story/news/politics/2017/11/20/prominent-missouri-political-operative-implicated-fec-dark-money-investigation/882210001/>

I contend that there is sufficient evidence of coordination between USTL, MSCF, Luetkemeyer and an unknown donor, that USTL should be compelled to file as a committee and report the contributions of its donors. USTL's contributions were evidently designated for candidate Luetkemeyer and should be subject to campaign contribution limits. The same should be true for any unknown donor to USTL that designated a contribution for candidate Luetkemeyer.

Please take note of the \$99,978.72 contribution from Herzog to MAF-GRPAC on 7/13/18 and the \$100,000.00 contribution from MAF-GRPAC to MSCF on 7/24/18, just 11 days later. The difference in the amounts, \$21.28 is trivial when compared to the total contributions. Given that Al Landes is both the COO of Herzog (see <https://www.herzog.com/contacts/>) and also the treasurer of Luetkemeyer for Senate, and further given that Thomas is the treasurer for both MAF-GRPAC and MSCF, it is evident that coordination occurred to

obscure the true origin of the contribution and also evident that the contribution was designated for candidate Luetkemeyer. You can see from the attached copies that Herzog was a major contributor to MAF-GRPAC, having given MAF-GRPAC \$50,000 on 6/27/17. MAF-GRPAC also gave Luetkemeyer for Senate the maximum \$2600 contribution on 10/20/17.

I contend that the \$99,978.72 contribution was a pass-through of funds from Herzog to MSCF and was designated for candidate Luetkemeyer. I contend that this is sufficient evidence of coordination to require that the contribution be reported as a contribution to the Luetkemeyer campaign and be subject to campaign contribution limits.

I also offer this information:

The Ethics Commission may not be aware of the fact that Scot Van Meter filed to run as a Republican in the 34th district senate race on the last day of filing. Van Meter is a four-term Democratic Buchanan County Assessor, and his major donor, as can be seen from committee filings, was Al Landes, Luetkemeyer's treasurer. Further, as you can see at the Herzog website I cited above, his brother Ryan is a vice-president of Herzog. Further, his father, Art Van Meter, now deceased, was a long-time Herzog employee. Scot Van Meter withdrew from the race after the local GOP committee filed suit in circuit court. It is very likely Van Meter was recruited to run in that race in order to split the Buchanan County vote for Roberts; it is also likely that a Herzog employee recruited him.

Liberty Alliance is a committee with the same address of Thomas' other PACs: 7509 NW Tiffany Springs Parkway Suite 300, Kansas City, MO 64153, in Platte County. However, the Treasurer is listed as William Greim. On 7/27/17, Herzog Railroad Services, Inc. contributed \$100,000 to Liberty Alliance. On 10/26/17, Liberty Alliance contributed \$102,000 to MAF-GRPAC, another Thomas committee.

Herzog's history of contributing to committees treasured by Thomas, who then moved funds from one committee to another (suggesting coordination to obscure the original source of the contribution), the fact that Herzog's COO is Luetkemeyer's treasurer, and Herzog's connections to the Scot Van Meter story above suggest that Herzog may be the source of a large donation to USTL as well as the source of funding for the billboards put up by Darlington Road Corporation; the truth could easily be revealed through bank records.

Conclusion:

I would like to offer the following specific complaints in light of this MEC opinion: “**2017.02.CF.003** It is the Commission’s opinion that the contribution limits apply to candidate committees and only to continuing committees/political action committees if a contribution to that committee is restricted or designated for a candidate.”

When Roe contributed \$25,000 to SCF, he knew or should have known that his contribution was designated for candidate Chester. His company worked for both SCF and Chester’s candidate committee.

When SCF received the \$25,000 from Roe, Thomas the treasurer knew or should have known that the contribution was designated for candidate Chester. The committee was not involved in any other race.

When USTL contributed \$450,000 to MSCF, it knew or should have known that its contribution was designated for candidate Luetkemeyer. USTL would not have given any money that might have been used for a candidate that had not signed its pledge.

When MSCF received the USTL contributions, Thomas the treasurer knew or should have known that the contribution was designated for candidate Luetkemeyer. MSCF went on to spend \$450,000 of USTL money supporting Luetkemeyer.

It is likely that USTL accepted a contribution or contributions designated for candidate Luetkemeyer and routed them to MSCF.

When MAF-GRPAC received \$99,978.72 from Herzog, Thomas the treasurer himself transferred the funds (with an additional \$21.28) to MSCF, which he knew or should have known was designated for candidate Luetkemeyer. Al Landes, who likely made the donation to MAF-GRPAC on behalf of Herzog (Stan Herzog, CEO of Herzog, has been seriously ill for some months), is Luetkemeyer’s campaign treasurer.

When MSCF received the MAF-GRPAC contribution of \$100,000, Thomas the treasurer knew or should have known that the contribution was designated for candidate Luetkemeyer. As treasurer of both MAF-GRPAC and MSCF, he made all the disbursements for expenditures and filed all the reports showing support for Luetkemeyer.

When Herzog contributed \$99,978.72 to MAF-GRPAC, as Luetkemeyer’s campaign treasurer, Al Landes knew or should have known that the money was designated for candidate Luetkemeyer. Herzog would not have contributed

that sum not knowing for certain it would not be used against the candidate for whom Al Landes was treasurer.

Furthermore, it appears that each of the individuals and entities about whom I have complained above violated Article VIII, Section 23, 3 (7), which states: “No contribution shall be made or accepted, directly or indirectly, in a fictitious name, in the name of another person, or by or through another person in such a manner as to conceal the identity of the actual source of the contribution or the actual recipient.”

I have offered evidence of multiple instances of coordination between these individuals and entities. While coordination itself is not illegal, those who participated in the coordination should be required to reveal their donors and be subject to campaign contribution limits.

Article VIII, Section 23 of the Missouri Constitution was passed by Missouri voters with the expectation that contributions limits would apply equally to everyone and that the true sources of campaign contributions should not be obscured. I am asking the Ethics Committee to investigate further the complaints I have brought above in addition to the complaint I have already filed against Darlington Road Corporation and Robert Spretnak; to find that these entities must disclose their donors; to enforce the law regarding contribution limits; and to assess whatever penalties are justified by your findings.
